



I Dare You Leadership Award Nomination Form

Due December 31

Each year, Lancaster County 4-H selects two 4-H members who are juniors or seniors to be awarded I Dare You Leadership Awards on behalf of the American Youth Foundation. Lancaster County 4-H Council provides award recipients with a hardbound copy of William H. Danforth's classic motivational book, *I Dare You!*

The award recognizes youth who strive to be their personal best and make a positive difference in their schools, youth groups, 4-H clubs, and communities. They do not need to hold leadership positions currently, but should be recognized by peers and adults who work with them as emerging leaders.

Nominations may be made by 4-H leaders, parents or friends. They may also be self-nominated.

Recipients will be announced at Lancaster County 4-H Achievement Night (usually held in February).

The I Dare You Leadership Award was first offered in 1941 by William H. Danforth. Mr. Danforth was a successful businessman who dared young people to achieve their highest potential and to influence others through lives of leadership and service. The I Dare You Leadership Award recognizes those who, with a little encouragement, are ready to see themselves as leaders—young adults who are ready to take the dare.
