The **4-H Corner Stop** food booth at the Lancaster County Super Fair is Lancaster County 4-H Council's primary fundraiser. The food booth has windows in the Lincoln Room and Multipurpose Arena.

**4-H Council asks clubs and independent members to help by staffing a shift at the 4-H Corner Stop.**

At any given time, 6 youth (age 8 & up) and 4 adults are needed. Youth gain practical experience handling food safely and counting change.

They also gain life skills, such as responsibility, critical thinking and social skills.

4-H Council financially supports several important 4-H programs and activities such as: Achievement Celebration, 4-H Information Night (formerly Kick Off); college and camp scholarships; support for state and national contest registrations; and much more!
