Newer riders and green horses can practice for district competition, too! Walk/trot pleasure and equitation classes have been added for all 4-H divisions. You and your horse may show in both the walk/trot classes and canter/lope classes since we have limitations on our warm-up times.

PRACTICE FOR DISTRICT SHOWS

This clinic/show will be set up in the district format and all 4-H age groups, as well as non-4-H'ers, can participate. Nebraska 4-H attire and armbands are required (for 4-H'ers), but ID sheets are not needed for this show.

COMBINED CLINIC/SHOW FORMAT

Depending on size of the classes and show, the judge will be able to do some teaching and commenting at the end of the classes. This feedback is designed to help participants learn how to further improve their riding.

CLASS FEES

There will be a one time office charge of \$5 for Wranglers members and \$10 for non-members plus a \$4 charge per class. Non-4-H'ers are also welcome!

Concessions will be provided by Lancaster Event Center. Stalls and campsites are available, but horses may be shown from trailers. Only outdoor round pens and the scheduled arena times are available for warm-up.
