WHEREAS, 4-H provides young people with community, mentors and learning opportunities to develop the skills they need to create positive change in their lives and communities; and


WHEREAS, Lancaster County 4-H is delivered by University of Nebraska-Lincoln Extension in cooperation with Lancaster County government.
