

4-H Member & Leader Online Enrollment

Must be Completed at <http://v2.4honline.com> by June 15 for Youth to Participate in the Fair

All 4-H members, organizational leaders and project leaders must re-enroll every year. (Note: project volunteers and parent helpers do not need to enroll as volunteers.) The website to enroll or re-enroll is 4-H Online at <https://v2.4honline.com>. Step-by-step instructions for new and returning members, as well as new and returning club leaders, are at <https://4h.unl.edu/enroll>. The state enrollment deadline for youth participation in county/state fair is June 15. However, new members and volunteers may enroll any time of the year.

MEMBERS: Only parents/guardians may enroll 4-H members. There is no fee to enroll in 4-H in Lancaster County. Each 4-H household will need to initially set up a profile in which the 4-H members and/or leaders in the household will be added. For returning families, please do not create a new account — use your previous log-in credentials. For enrollment to be complete, at least one project and one club need to be selected. The only required health information for members is regarding allergies. The rest is needed only if a child is planning to attend an overnight camp or campus event. Whether you fully complete the health section or not, at the end of this section, make sure to provide your confirmation of “Permission to Treat” in order for you to move to the next screens to complete the enrollment.

INDEPENDENT MEMBERS: 4-H members who do not wish to join a formal 4-H club are “independent members” and need to select “Lancaster Independent” under “club.”

FFA MEMBERS: FFA members need to select TCA FFA, Norris FFA, Raymond Central FFA, Waverly FFA or Crete FFA under “club.”

PROJECTS: See below.

LEADERS: In <https://v2.4honline.com>, choose organizational leader or project leader when enrolling, not project volunteer.

To Exhibit Projects in the Fair, 4-H members Must be Enrolled in the Project Area(s) Must be completed at <http://v2.4honline.com> by June 15

To exhibit in the fair, 4-H members must be enrolled in the respective project (unless otherwise stated in the Fair Book). Previous year’s project selections will not appear or carry over.

Enrolled project examples: Home Environment–Design Decisions, Food & Nutrition–Cooking 101 and Rabbit. This does not include the specific fair classes within each project area, such as: wall hanging, baked cookies and rabbit breed class.

Fair exhibit examples which do not have specific projects to enroll in: Special County Exhibits, Posters and Banners.

Select projects at <https://v2.4honline.com> by June 15. NOTE: only 4-H parents/guardians may update projects.

When signing up for individual projects, note the abbreviations for the project areas. The abbreviations are on the 4-H Project List at <http://lancaster.unl.edu/4h/club/ProjectList.pdf> (and in this packet) to help you locate an individual project. For example, you will find “Design Decisions” under C&FS which stands for Consumer and Family Science instead of under ‘D’ or “Home Environment.”
