Designed for Lancaster County 4-H members who plan to attend any institution of higher learning. Each year, Lincoln Center Kiwanis awards one \$1,000 scholarship for a graduating senior enrolled in the Lancaster County 4-H program.

Basis of selection:

40%—4-H projects and/or program

25%—Scholastic standing

25%—Activity involvement

10%—Financial need

Recipients will be announced at Lancaster County 4-H Achievement Night (usually held in February).

Form must be submitted by mail or brought to the extension office — do not e-mail.

Conditions of acceptance:

Seniors must plan to enroll in post-secondary education immediately following graduation from high school. Scholarship money will be awarded when candidate has shown he/she is a full-time student in good academic standing, has completed one semester, quarter, or block of classes (depending upon the school's academic schedule) post-graduation, and has enrolled for an immediate second term.
