Master Health Volunteer training is approximately 40 hours of classes and supplemental learning.

- volunteer 40 hours on Extension-approved projects that enhance health in the community
- track and submit hours
- maintain Nebraska
 Extension's mission of

 enhance their lives
 through research-based
 information."
