- Horticulture, Landscape, and Environmental Systems
- Agricultural Profitability
- Food, Nutrition & Health
- Early Childhood
- Rural Prosperity Nebraska
- Water and Cropping Systems

The Lancaster County Extension Board typically meets monthly. The monthly meetings are usually held the second Friday of the month at 8 a.m. at Nebraska Extension in Lancaster County, 444 Cherrycreek Road, Suite A, Lincoln. The term of appointment is three years.
