



Get Involved in 4-H!

In Nebraska, 4-H is open to all youth ages 5–18 (as of Jan. 1 of current year). There are three ways to get involved with Lancaster County 4-H.

HELP START A NEW 4-H CLUB

4-H clubs provide a group learning environment for the positive development of young people. Families are encouraged to help organize a new club — which is a lot easier than you may think! 4-H staff provides guidance and resource materials. Clubs have at least five members and are led (or co-led) by club leaders — often club members' parents.

JOIN AN EXISTING 4-H CLUB

4-H clubs provide a group learning environment for the positive development of

young people. Clubs usually participate in one or more projects together. Youth members may choose officers. Many existing clubs in Lancaster County are at capacity, so consider helping start a new 4-H club.

BE AN INDEPENDENT MEMBER

Independent 4-H members participate in planned learning outside of a club setting. Their work is self-directed with guidance and support of parents and mentors.
