### You need a rabbit

Study different breeds. Consider rabbit size and temperament. Talk to local breeders. It is usually better to purchase your rabbit from a reputable breeder.

If you like rabbits, hop to it! One Lancaster County 4-H club focus on rabbits, as well as a variety of other projects. Open to all youth ages 8–18.



## **Supplies needed**

Cage**	\$50-100 for supplied start up k	it
Bedding for waste	\$4-9 for pine shavings or pellet	bedding
Water bottle	\$5	-
Food dish	\$3-\$10	M
Pellet food	\$6 (2lb) to \$30 (50lb)	ET
Grooming brush	\$8	
Nail trimmer	\$6-9	a cob
(**for small rabbit breeds —	use a 24″ x 24″ x 16″ cage)
